## Mandatory Classroom Session & Test

The classroom session is held from 10am to 3pm at the Ramada Inn, at the intersection of HWY 251 and HWY 75 (Exit 1 off I39 & I90), in South Beloit, IL.

The classroom session includes the following sections:

Grand Prix Technique, Driving Blackhawk Farms Raceway, Flags, Hand Signals, Rules of the Road, Rules & Regulations, Rules of the Pits, Licensing Procedures, followed by a written exam.

**New Wheel-to-Wheels Students are required to attend all of the classroom sessions and take the written test. Current Novice license-holders wishing to attend for a novice sign-off are not required to attend the class, but may do so if they wish. \*\*Deadline to register for sign-off's is listed below and is the same as FC track timer's. PRE-PAYMENT AND PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED. Full refund if cancelled by midnight April 12 or July 12, depending on the school date.**

**Only wheel-to-wheel students that must travel great distance to attend the mandatory classroom session may make a special appointment to take the written test on the Friday prior to the on-track drivers school. Special appointments must be made with the MCSCC Driver School Registrar.**

**\*\*A limited number of slots may be available to current (2009) Full Competition License-holders with Midwestern Council to run the school for track time only. Current (2009) MC novice license-holders requesting a sign-off follow the same registration/cancellation deadlines as track timer's, but are not restricted in number. Requests must be made to the MCSCC Driver School Registrar (for track timer's) prior to the final registration deadline, which is extended to April 15 or July 15. PRE-PAYMENT AND PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED. Full refund if cancelled by midnight April 15 or July 15.**
